ORDINANCE NO. 26-33

By Mr. C. L. Crippen.

Authorizing E. R. Reeves to alter approaches to filling station at corner of Main Street and Sheridan Avenue and construction of curb at said intersection.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That E. R. Reeves be and he hereby is authorized to reduce the width of the west approach to the filling station located at the southwest corner of Main Street and Sheridan Avenue from 52 feet to 34 feet and to cut a new approach east of said present approach; the width of the same not to exceed 32 feet. The present stone curbing shall be re-set on the closed portion of said west approach. In the event that the premises whereon said filling station is located shall cease to be used for business purposes requiring drive-in entrances, the said E. R. Reeves, or his successors in title to said premises, shall re-place the curbing at such approaches, and by his acceptance of this ordinance the said E. R. Reeves does bind himself, his heirs and assigns, to the terms hereof.

section 2. The said E. R. Reeves is hereby given permission at his own cost and expense to widen the entrance from Main Street to Sheridan Abenue by setting these the curb at the southwest corner thereof upon a 30 ft. radius and to resonstruct said curb of reenforced concrete and to connect the present paving of Sheridan Avenue with said curb as re-constructed with 8 inch concrete pavement. He shall also re-construct the sidewalks at said intersection so as to provide a sidewalk of not less than five feet in width. Said work shall be done to the approval of the Street Commissioner and the Engineers of the City of Bexley. Proper lights and danger warnings shall be maintained by said E. R. Reeves during said construction.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period ellowed by law.
