## ORDINANCE NU. 28-33

By Mr. C. L. Crippen.

Authorizing A. H. Marquert to cut curb for entrance to filling station on Cassady Road.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That A. H. Marquart, being the owner of the premises at the northeast corner of Ruhl Avenue and Cassady Road, upon which he has constructed a gascline filling station, is hereby authorized and empowered to cut and remove the curb on the north side of Ruhl Avenue at said location for the purpose of constructing two twenty-four foot driveways into said filling station. The corners at the entrance to said driveways to be rounded by the construction of circular curb, all to the satisfaction of the Superintendent of Streets.

Section 2. The said A. H. Marquart, by the acceptance of the provisions hereof, does hereby bind himself, his heirs and assigns, that in the event said premises shall cease to be used for gasoline filling station purposes, or other business purposes requiring entrances, he will replace the curb so removed and restore the same to their original condition.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the period allowed by law.
