

ORDINANCE NO. 36-33

By Mr. Pretzman.

To establish the location and the grade of the curb on the south side of Fair Avenue from Park Drive to Westland Avenue.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the location and the permanent grade of the curb on the south side of Fair Avenue from Park Drive to Westland Avenue shall be, and are hereby revised and established as follows, and future improvements shall be made with reference thereto, to-wit:

SOUTH CURB:

Beginning at Station 0+00 at the center line of Park Drive and at Elevation 76.00; thence, easterly on a vertical curve, the end of which is at Station 1+00, with the following Stations and Elevations:

Station 0+25	Elevation 76.23
" 0+50	" 76.70
" 0+75	" 77.43
" 1+00	" 78.40

thence, easterly on an ascending grade of 4.40% to Station 2 25; and Elevation 83.90; thence, easterly on a vertical curve, the end of which is at Station 3 35; with the following Stations and Elevations:

Station 2+50	Elevation 84.90
" 2+75	" 85.67
" 3+00	" 86.24
" 3+25	" 86.59
" 3+35	" 86.68

thence, easterly on an ascending grade of 0.66% to the center line of Preston Road at Station 5+31.6 and Elevation 87.98; thence easterly on a 1.68% ascending grade to Station 7+71.8 and Elevation 92.00, which point is 30 feet west of the east line of Westland Avenue. The face of the curb is to be located 17 feet south of and parallel to the center line of Fair Avenue, which is a 60 ft. street.

The above elevations shall be held to refer to City datum.

The above grade and location are in accordance with a plat thereof prepared by the City Engineer and approved by the City Engineer and Director of Public Service of the City of Columbus, Ohio, (for the reason that the north half of said street

is in the City of Columbus, and the south half in the City of Bexley), a copy of which plat shall be filed in the office of the Mayor.

Section 2. That any and all ordinances in conflict with the provisions hereof be and the same are hereby repealed.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
