

ORDINANCE NO. 40-33.

By Mr. Pretzman.

To establish the grade of curbs and sidewalks on Charles Street from the east line of Sheridan Avenue to the west line of College Avenue in the City of Bexley, Ohio.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the permanent grade of the north curb of Charles Street from the east line of Sheridan Avenue to the west line of College Avenue shall be and the same is hereby established, and sidewalks and future improvements shall be constructed with reference thereto, to-wit:

NORTH CURB:

Beginning at station 0+00 on the east line of Sheridan Avenue at elevation 86.50; thence, on a 2.10% ascending grade to station 2+30 at elevation 91.53; thence, with a vertical curve through the following stations and elevations:

Station 2+40	Elevation 91.50
" 2+50	" 91.58
" 2+60	" 91.62
" 2+70	" 91.54

the end of said vertical curve; thence, with a 1.08% descending grade to station 3+57, the west line of College Avenue at elevation 90.60.

SOUTH CURB:

Same grade and elevation as the north curb.

The sidewalk area shall have a slope of $\frac{3}{8}\%$ per foot toward the curb with a 1" drop at curb height.

The above elevations shall be held to refer to City Datum.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
