

## ORDINANCE NO. 42-33.

Appropriating funds for the cost of materials and miscellaneous expenses for engineering services for relief projects under Civil Works Program.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That there be and is hereby appropriated from the Streets Maintenance and Repair, Motor Vehicle License Fund the following sums to pay that portion of the cost of necessary materials and incidental miscellaneous expenses which are to be borne by the City of Bexley in the following relief projects under the Civil Works Program, heretofore approved, to-wit:

- (a) Mound Street grading, paving and draining from Sheridan Avenue to College Avenue. \$1900.00
- (b) Widening the Drexel Avenue pavement and necessary incidentals thereto. \$1700.00
- (c) Grading and surfacing Charles Street from Euclaire Avenue to east corporation line.

Grading and surfacing Westland Avenue between Bryden Road and Fair Avenue.

Grading and surfacing Denver Avenue from Ashbourne Road to Gould Road.

Repair of Powell Avenue from Parkview Avenue to Drexel Avenue.

Repair of Elm Avenue from Columbia Avenue to Lawson Avenue.

Repair of Dale Avenue from Parkview Avenue to Dawson Avenue.

Grading, draining and surfacing alley east of Euclaire Avenue from alley south of Astor to alley south of Main Street.

Grading, draining and surfacing <sup>the</sup> alley east of Cassingham from alley north of Livingston to alley south of Main. \$600.00

- (d) Widening of the street returns on the south side of Main Street at Sheridan Avenue, Euclaire Avenue, Cassingham Road, Montrose Avenue, Remington Road, and also grading and rebuilding sidewalk on the south side of Main Street east from Cassingham for a distance of approximately 175 feet. \$1,000.00

Also there is appropriated from said fund the additional sum of \$1500.00 to pay the necessary engineering services in the various work relief projects under said Civil Works Program.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
