

RESOLUTION NO. 2-34.

By Mr. Altmaier.

Authorizing the Mayor to execute necessary application under Civil Works Program for the following work relief project, to-wit: Being the improvement of Remington Road from Main Street to the south line of the property of the Board of Education of the Bexley School District by grading, draining and paving with re-enforced concrete.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor be and he hereby is authorized to execute the necessary application or applications for approval of work relief project under the Civil Works Program and authority to pay relief labor in cash for the following proposed project within the City of Bexley, Franklin County, Ohio, to-wit: The improvement of Remington Road from Main Street to the south line of the property of the Board of Education of the Bexley City School District by grading, draining and paving the roadway thereof with reenforced concrete, with concrete curbs and gutters, and concrete sidewalks in accordance with the plans, profiles, specifications and estimates prepared by the engineers and now on file in the office of the Mayor and which are hereby approved.

Section 2. This Resolution is an emergency resolution and necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that large numbers of citizens are unemployed and it is necessary that said project be gotten under way without delay, for which reason said resolution shall go into immediate force and effect.
