Authorizing the purchase of tar for the treatment of Astor Avenue, and the application thereof.


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:


Section 1. That the Mayor be and he is hereby authorized to purchase the necessary road tar for the surface treatment of Astor Avenue from College Avenue to Pleasant Ridge Avenue, and to have the same applied thereon, said application to be under the supervision of the Superintendent of Streets and to the approval of the engineers.

Section 2. That the sum of \$225.00 be and the same is hereby appropriated from the Streets Maintenance and Repair Motor Vehicle License Fund.


Section 3. This ordinance is an emergency ordinance and necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that the materials for said street have been furnished and said street resurfaced there-with under the Civil Works Administration, and that it is necessary to treat the same with tar as hereinabove provided without unnecessary delay, and said ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect.
