

ORDINANCE NO. 12-34.

By Mr. Stackhouse.

To establish the grade of curbs and sidewalks on
Powell Avenue from Westland Avenue to Parkview Avenue.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the permanent grade of the curbs on
Powell Avenue from Westland Avenue to Parkview Avenue shall be and the same is hereby
changed and established as follows, and the sidewalks and future
improvements shall be constructed with reference thereto, to-wit:

SOUTH CURB: Between Westland Avenue and Parkview Avenue.

Beginning at station 0+00 at the east
property line of Westland Avenue at elevation 103.64;
thence easterly on an 0.89% ascending grade to the
west line of Parkview Avenue at station 2+42 and
elevation 105.80.

NORTH CURB:

The grade of the north curb shall be the
same as the south curb.

Said south and north curbs shall be located
15 feet from the center line of the street.

SIDEWALK GRADE: Between Westland Avenue and Parkview Ave.

The inside edge of the sidewalk, that is
the edge next to the property line, on both sides of
the street shall be located one foot from the property
line and 2½ inches above and parallel to the curb grade.

The above elevations shall be held to refer
to City Datum.

Section 2. The grades of the curbs and sidewalks as
herein established for that portion of Powell Avenue between
Westland Avenue and Parkview Avenue shall be held to govern as
against the grades heretofore established therefor by Ordinance No.
1075, passed July 8th, 1930.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in
force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
