

## ORDINANCE NO. 13-34.

By Mr. Manly.

Authorizing the employment of special counsel to assist in certain pending litigation.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That whereas, there are now pending in the Common Pleas Court of Franklin County, Ohio, ten cases, being numbered 138,322, 138,404, 138,405, 138,406, 138,407, 138,408, 138,409, 138,410, 138,453, and 140,445, wherein it is sought by the respective plaintiffs in said cases to recover damages against the City of Bexley for the alleged pollution of Alum Creek, which cases will require a great amount of work in the preparation and trial thereof, and it is deemed by council to be to the best interests of the City of Bexley to employ special counsel to assist the Solicitor in such preparation and trial in the Common Pleas Court or any review thereof, the Solicitor is hereby authorized and empowered to employ a reputable attorney as special counsel for said purpose. The sum of \$500.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Fund to provide for such employment.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
