

Ordinance No. 21-34

Providing for the appointment of special detectives.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor be and he hereby is authorized to commission such special detectives as he may deem necessary, at a compensation of \$10.00 per day for time actually employed.

Section 2. Such special detectives shall act under the direction and control of the Chief of Police, and such rules and regulations as the Mayor shall from time to time provide. No such commission shall be valid for more than thirty days from the date thereof, and no person shall be so commissioned who is not a citizen of the United States.

Section 3. This ordinance is an emergency ordinance, and necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and shall go into immediate force and effect.
