Amending the preamble to Ordinance to 19-34, Passed June 12, 1934.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

section 1. That the preamble to Ordinance No. 19-34, providing for the issuance of bonds of the C ity of Bexley, Ohio, for the purpose of paying the municipality's portion of the cost of improving Broad Street (being State Highway No. 47) from the east end of the bridge over Alum Creek to the east corporation line, being that portion of said street lying within the corporate limits of said City, which improvement is being made in cooperation with the Director of Highways of the State of Ohio, be amended as follows:

whereas, this Council has requested the Clerk to issue his certificate as to the estimated life of the improvements to be constructed from the proceeds of the bonds hereinafter referred to, and the Clerk has certified to this Council such estimated life as exceeding five years, and has further certified the maximum maturity of such bonds as ten years, and

Whereas, the notes, issued in anticipation of the issuance of the bonds hereinafter referred to, are about to fall due, NOW, THEREFORE:

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
