

## ORDINANCE NO. 26-34

By Mr. Klingbeil.

Providing for the purchase of materials for bituminous surface treatment of that portion of Gould Road lying within the City of Bexley between Main Street and the North property line of St. Catherine's School.

Whereas, Gould Road lies one-half within the City of Bexley, and one-half within the City of Columbus, and it is proposed to repair that portion of Gould Road between Main Street and the north property line of St. Catherine's School by resurfacing the same with bituminous macadam, and it will be necessary to purchase material for such bituminous macadam for that portion within the City of Bexley in the sum of \$200.00, NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That there be and hereby is appropriated from the Maintenance and Repair of Streets, Gasoline Fund the sum of \$200.00 to provide for the purchase of bituminous materials for said purpose, and the Mayor is hereby authorized to make such purchase, and to cause said improvement to be made.

Section 2. This ordinance is an emergency ordinance and necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that the approach of cold weather requires that said improvement shall be made without delay and this ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect.
