

## ORDINANCE NO. 29-34

Settling claim of C. O. Bradshaw for damages to automobile.

Whereas, C. O. Bradshaw has presented a claim to Council in the sum of \$7.15 for damages which he claims to have been caused to his automobile on July 5th, 1934 by reason of a loose manhole cover in Drexel Avenue at Fair Avenue, which damaged the springs and chassis of his automobile in the above amount, and

Whereas, Council after investigation of the matter is of the opinion that there is a probable liability therefor on the part of the City, and that said claim should be settled, NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the claim of said C. O. Bradshaw for damages to his automobile, as hereinabove recited, in the sum of \$7.15 be allowed and paid, upon the receipt of a proper release on behalf of said claimant, his heirs, administrators and assigns, in full of all claims, demands, damages, actions and causes of action, resulting from or growing out of said accident. The sum of \$7.15 is hereby appropriated for said purpose from the General Fund.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
