Settling the claims of Robert V. Weatherman and Niesel Weatherman, his wife, for damages to person and automobile.

whereas, Robert V. Weatherman and Niesel Weatherman, his wife, have presented claims to council in the sums of \$28.35 for damages to the automobile of said Robert V. Weatherman, and of \$5.50 for personal injuries sustained by Niesel Weatherman, which damages and injuries were sustained on August 3rd, 1934 by reason of a collision between the automobile of said Robert V. Weatherman and one R. D. Wagner, occurring at the time that said Robert V. Weatherman was engaged in assisting the police of the City of Bexley in moving one of the police cars at or near the intersection of East Main Street and Montrose Avenue, and

Whereas, Council after investigation of the matter is of the opinion that there is a probable liability therefor on the part of said municipality, and that said claims should be settled, NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the claim of said Robert V. Weatherman for damages to his automobile arising out of said automobile accident, as herein above set forth, be allowed and paid in the sum of \$28.35, and the claim of said Niesel Weatherman, for personal injuries arising out of said automobile accident, as hereinabove set forth, be allowed and paid in said sum of \$5.50, upon the receipt of proper releases on behalf of said claimants, their heirs, administrators and assigns, in full of all claims, demands, damages, actions, and causes of action, resulting from or growing out of said accident. The sum of \$33.85 is hereby appropriated for said purpose from the General Fund.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
