

## ORDINANCE NO. 34-34

Appropriating moneys for the cost of materials, rental of equipment and engineering services for project under Federal Emergency Relief Administration, said project being the repairing and improving of Remington Road from Fair Avenue to Brentwood Road.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That it is hereby determined to be necessary to repair and improve Remington Road from Fair Avenue to Brentwood Road by constructing a storm sewer therein and grading and resurfacing the same with water bound macadam in accordance with the plans, profiles, specifications and estimates heretofore prepared by the engineers, and on file in the office of the Mayor, and which are hereby approved, the labor for which improvement is to be furnished by the Federal Emergency Relief Administration and the materials, rental of equipment, and engineering services to be furnished by the City of Bexley, the application therefor having been approved by said Federal Emergency Relief Administration.

Section 2. That there be and is hereby appropriated from the Streets, Maintenance and Repair, M.V.L. Fund the sum of \$950.00 to be paid for the necessary materials, rental of equipment and engineering services for said project.

Section 3. That this ordinance is an emergency ordinance and necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that Fair Avenue adjacent to said improvement is lower than Remington Road causing stagnant water to collect and remain there, which would be remedied by said improvement, for which reason said ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect.
