

ORDINANCE NO. 35-34.

Providing for construction of water mains in Livingston Avenue from College Avenue to Euclaire Avenue, and a water main connecting therewith in Francis Avenue and extending a distance of 330 feet.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That it is necessary to construct and there shall be constructed an eight (8) inch water line in Livingston Avenue, from College Avenue to Euclaire Avenue, and a six (6) inch water line in Francis Avenue, extending from said proposed line in Livingston Avenue to a point 330 feet northerly therefrom, said line being necessary for a proper supply of water to the abutting properties for domestic use and sanitary purposes, in accordance with the plans, profiles, estimates and specifications therefor heretofore prepared by the engineers and on file in the office of the Mayor.

Section 2. Whereas, it is proposed that the City of Bexley shall provide the materials for said improvement, consisting of cast iron pipes and appurtenances, and the engineering services and incidental expenses, and that the labor in connection with making said improvement shall be furnished by the Federal Emergency Relief Administration; the engineers are hereby authorized and instructed to make application to said Federal Emergency Relief Administration for acceptance of such project and the furnishing of such labor.

Section 3. That there be and hereby is appropriated from the Water Fund the sum of \$2,500.00 for the City's portion of the cost and expense of said improvement as hereinabove provided.

Section 4. That a proper charge shall hereafter be fixed by Council for water connections to be paid by the owners of properties bounding and abutting upon said improvement on Livingston Avenue and on Francis Avenue, the same to be paid at the time such connections are made, and the amounts charged therefor shall be deposited to the credit of the Water Fund.

Section 5. This ordinance is an emergency ordinance, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that properties abutting upon said proposed improvement are without adequate water for domestic and sanitary purposes, and said ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect.
