

## ORDINANCE NO. 40-34.

appropriating additional moneys for the cost of materials, rental of equipment and engineering services for project under Federal Emergency Relief Administration, said project being the repairing and improving of Remington Road from Fair Avenue to Brentwood Road.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That whereas, the moneys heretofore appropriated for the cost of materials, rental of equipment, and engineering services for project under Federal Emergency Relief Administration, being the repairing and improving of Remington Road from Fair Avenue to Brentwood Road, is insufficient to complete said project, and an additional sum of \$300.00 will be required for the completion thereof, there is hereby appropriated said additional amount of \$300.00 from the Streets Maintenance and Repair Motor Vehicle License Fund for said purpose.

Section 2. That this ordinance is an emergency ordinance and necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that Fair Avenue adjacent to said improvement is lower than Remington Road causing stagnant water to collect and remain there, which would be remedied by said improvement, for which reason said ordinance shall go into immediate effect.
