

ORDINANCE NO. 5-35.

By Mr. Stackhouse.

Providing for the improvement of Mound Street from College Avenue to Sheridan Avenue.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That it is necessary to improve Mound Street from College Avenue to Sheridan Avenue by constructing a 12 inch storm sewer therein in accordance with the plans, profiles, estimates and specifications therefor heretofore prepared by the engineers and on file in the office of the Mayor, which are hereby approved.

Section 2. Whereas, it is proposed that the City of Bexley shall provide the materials for said improvement and the engineering services and incidental expenses, and that the labor in connection with making said improvement shall be furnished by the Federal Emergency Relief Administration, the engineers are hereby authorized and instructed to make application to said Federal Emergency Relief Administration for the expense of such project, and the furnishing of such labor.

Section 3. That there be and hereby is appropriated from the Street Maintenance and Repair, Gasoline Tax Fund the sum of \$800.00, for the cost of said materials and incidental expenses and engineering services for said improvement, as hereinabove provided.

Section 4. That the Mayor be and he is hereby authorized and directed to make and execute a contract for the purchase of said materials with the lowest and best bidder after advertisement according to law.

Section 5. This ordinance is an emergency ordinance, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that said street is without proper drainage, and said ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect.
