RESOLUTION NO. 6-35.

Authorizing the set-off of certain monies due the City of Bexley against funds due to said City of Columbus, Ohio.

BE IT RESOLVED, that whereas, the City of Bexley is indebted to the City of Columbus in the sum of \$8,125.00 under its contract providing for fire protection, which amount is due and payable, and the City of Columbus is indebted to the City of Bexley in the sum of \$6,684.48 for money had end received by the City of Columbus from the State of Ohio in the settlement of gasoline taxes and motor vehicle license fees for the years 1930 and 1931, which amounts were rightly due to the City of Bexley, but were paid to said City of Columbus through mistake, and for which a finding has been made in favor of the said City of Bexley against the City of Columbus, by the Bureau of Inspection and Supervision of Public Offices, in the State of Ohio, in said sum of \$6,684.48, the Auditor be, and hereby is, authorized at the time of issuing voucher to the City of Columbus to set-off and deduct from the amount so due said City of Columbus under said contract, the amount so due from the City of Columbus to the City of Bexley, and to issue his voucher for the difference between said amount, to-wit: the sum of \$1440.52.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the action of the Mayor and Auditor in claiming said set-off in proceedings in aid of execution now pending in the Common Pleas Court of Franklin County, Ohio, in Cases Nos. 138,488 and 138,489, wherein said set-off was claimed on behalf of the City of Bexley, be ratified and confirmed by council as fully as if the same had been authorized by council prior to the filing of the answers in said cases, and the action of council at a special meeting of ecember 20th, 1935, authorizing such set-off, be and the same is hereby ratified and confirmed.
