roviding for the maintenance and repair of certain asphalt streets, roads and avenues in the City of Bexley, Ohio.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That, whereas, Brentwood Road from Drexel Avenue to Remington Road; Cassady Road from Brentwood Road to Broad Street; Cassingham Road from Livingston Avenue to Main Street; Chelsea Road from Livingston Avenue to Main Street; College Avenue from Livingston Avenue to Main Street; Columbia Avenue from Maryland Avenue to S. Commonwealth Avenue; Drexel Avenue from Broad Street to Maryland Avenue; Grandon Avenue from Main Street to Livingston Avenue; Meadow Park Drive from Broad Street to the end thereof; Parkview Avenue from Main Street to Caroline Avenue; and Roosevelt Road from Livingston Avenue to Main Street, are in need of repairs, so that the same may be maintained as proper highways, said streets, roads and avenues between said points shall be repaired by patching, sealing the cracks, and/or giving surface treatment, in accordance with the specifications and estimates thereof prepared by the engineers and one file in the office of the Mayor, which are hereby approved.

Section 2. That the entire cost of said repairs shall be paid by the City, and the sum of \$4,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the Street Maintenance and Repair Fund (M. V. L.) and \$4,500.00 from the Street Maintenance and Repair Fund (Gas.) for the purpose of paying the cost of said repairs.

Section 3. That the Mayor be and he is hereby authorized and directed to advertise for bids for the making of said repairs according to law.

Section 4. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency ordinance, and necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace and safety, by reason of the fact that said streets are fast detoriating and that places are becoming unsafe for traffic, and said ordinance shall go into immediate effect.
