

ORDINANCE NO. 11-35.

By. Mr. F. H. Bonnet.

To appropriate money for expense in connection with the paving of Mound Street from College Avenue to Sheridan Avenue.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That whereas, Mound Street between College Avenue and Sheridan Avenue is being paved by the Federal Emergency Administration of Public Works under agreement whereby said administration is furnishing all labor and concrete for the base and the City of Bexley has heretofore furnished the necessary brick and curbing, and it will be necessary for the City to furnish certain miscellaneous materials, equipment and truck hire and engineering, in accordance with the plans, specifications, estimates and profiles on file in the office of the Clerk, the Mayor be and hereby is authorized to purchase such necessary materials, and supplies, and rent the necessary equipment, and employ the necessary trucks and labor, said truck and driver not to exceed \$1.00 per hour, and to have said work done according to said plans and specifications.

Section 2. The sum of \$1,200.00 is hereby appropriated from the Street Maintenance and Repair Fund (Gas.) for the expense of said materials, equipment, truck hire and engineering services, in the completion of said project.

Section 5. This ordinance is an emergency ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and the same shall go into immediate force and effect.
