

## ORDINANCE NO. 15-35.

By Mr. Altmaier.

Authorizing the purchase of two automobile trucks for the Service Department.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract for the purchase of two automobile truck chassis, each being one and one-half ton chassis with closed cabs, and dual wheels with 30x5 heavy duty, 8 ply tires, front and rear, and equipped with Marion A20, 2 yard bodies, or equivalent, and Marion #26 Hydraulic hoist, or equivalent, and not to exceed \$1,000.00 each in price.

Section 2. That said contract shall be entered into with the lowest and best bidder after advertisement had according to law. The sum of \$2,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the Streets Maintenance and Repair Motor Vehicle License Fund for the purpose aforesaid.

Section 3. This ordinance is an emergency ordinance and necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that said trucks are necessary for the carrying forward of said repair work, said streets being in need of immediate repair, and said ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect.
