

ORDINANCE NO. 16-35.

By Mr. Altmaier.

Providing for the maintenance of Dale Avenue from Cassady Road to Cassingham Avenue.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That for the maintenance of Dale Avenue from Cassady Road to Cassingham Avenue the Mayor be and he is hereby authorized to purchase tarvia and to have same applied as surface treatment upon Dale Avenue between the aforesaid points, and the sum of \$300.00 is hereby appropriated from the Streets Maintenance and Repair Gasoline Tax Fund for said purpose.

Section 2. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace and safety, by reason of the fact that said street is in need of immediate repair and improvement to prevent same becoming unsafe for traffic, and said ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect.
