ORDINANCE NO. 18-35.

Providing for the maintenance and repair of certain streets, roads and avenues in the City of Eexley, Chio. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF CHIO:

Section 1. That whereas, Mound Street I from Euclaire Avenue to Remington Road; Remington Road from Brentwood Road to Fair Avenue; Astor Avenue from Pleasant Ridge Avenue to College Avenue; Charles Street from College Avenue to Sheridan Avenue; and Clifton Avenue from Parkview Avenue to Alum Creek, are in need of repairs so that the same may be maintained as proper highways, said streets, roads and avenues between said points shall be repaired by the application of a coat of tarvia in accordance with the specifications and estimates thereof prepared by the engineers and on file in the office of the Mayor, which are hereby approved.

Section 2. That the entire cost of said repairs shall be paid by the City, and the sum of \$800.00 is hereby appropriated from the Streets Maintenance and Repair Gasoline Tax Fund for the purpose of paying the cost thereof.

Section 3. That the Mayor be and he is hereby authorized and directed to advertise for bids for the purchase of the necessarymaterials and making of said repairs according to law, and to enter into contract therefor.

Section 4. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency ordinance, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace and safety, by reason of the fact that said streets are fast deteriorating and becoming unsafe for traffic , and said ordinance shall go into i mediate effect.
