

## ORDINANCE NO. 20-35.

By Mr. Schneider.

Appropriating money for miscellaneous engineering services on Federal Emergency Administration of Public Works projects.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That whereas, under the various Federal Emergency Administration of Public Works projects, miscellaneous services of the engineers are required other than those covered by the percentages contained in the contract of employment, the sum of \$500.00 is hereby appropriated from the Streets Maintenance and Repair Gasoline Tax Fund for the payment of such services.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
