

ORDINANCE NO. 21-35.

By Mr. Stackhouse.

Authorizing the Auditor to employ the necessary help in collecting information and serving notices relative to delinquent taxes and assessments.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Auditor be and he is hereby authorized and empowered to employ the necessary help to collect information and serve notices upon persons delinquent in the payment of taxes and special assessments in order to facilitate the collection thereof.

Section 2. That the sum of \$200.00 be and the same is hereby appropriated from the General Fund for the expense of said employment.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
