

ORDINANCE NO. 24-35.

By Mr. Otto Klingbeil.

Providing regulations for construction of private driveway entrances and the cutting of curbs therefor.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. In all cases where it is necessary to cut and remove curbs for the construction of private driveway entrances the same shall be done in accordance with the general plans and specifications heretofore prepared therefor by the engineers and now on file in the office of the Clerk of Council, which plans and specifications are hereby approved.

Section 2. The construction of such private driveway entrances and the re-setting of curbs so as to comply with said plans and specifications shall be under the supervision and to the approval of the Superintendent of Streets.

Section 5. This ordinance is an emergency measure and necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that streets are now being improved requiring the re-construction of driveways, for which reason said ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect.
