Providing for the improvement of Powell Avenue from Cassady Road to Gould Road, by grading, curbing and paving the roadway thereof with macadam, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

does determine that it is necessary to improve rowell avenue from Cassedy Road to Gould Road, by grading, curbing and paving the roadway thereof with macadam, and that it hereby determines to proceed with said improvement, all in accordance with the plans, specifications, estimates and profiles prepared by the engineers and on file in the office of the Mayor, which are hereby approved.

Administration of the Public Works of the United States has proposed and agreed to furnish all labor in the making of said improvement and a portion of the materials necessary therefor, and to make and perform said improvement on condition that the City of Bexley shall furnish the balance of said materials and the necessary engineering services, said balance of materials and the necessary services being in the estimated amount of \$5000.00, said improvement shall be made in accordance with said proposal and agreement, and the Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into a contract for the purchase of said materials, according to the plans specifications, estimates and profiles hereinabove referred to, after advertisement had according to law.

Section 3. That the sum of \$3000.00 is kereby appropriated from the Street Maintenance and Repair Gasoline Tax Fund for the payment of the cost of said materials and engineering setvices.

section 4. This ordinance is an emergency ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace and safety, said emergency being that said street is becoming dangerous to traffic and is in need of improvement, for which reason said ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect.
