

ORDINANCE NO. 31-35.

Authorizing payment of bill of B. F. Patterson.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:


Section 1. That whereas, B. F. Patterson was heretofore employed to dress curbing which was removed from East Broad Street for use on Mound Street at an agreed price of twenty-five cents per running foot, and in accordance therewith has submitted his statement in the sum of \$172.00 for dressing 688 feet of such curbing, which curbing has been used in said improvement of Mound Street, it is hereby ordered that said bill be allowed and paid and proper voucher issued therefor.

Section 2. The sum of \$172.00 is hereby appropriated from Mound Street Improvement Fund for the payment of said claim.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.


