Providing for payment to G. D. Brown on account of services rendered in recovery of motor vehicle license fees and excise taxes on motor vehicle fuel.

Whereas, under authority of Ordinance No. 18-33, passed on May 23, 1933, providing for the employment of G. D. Brown, accountant, to recover monies due the City of Bexley from the State of Ohio on account of motor vehicle license fees and excise taxes on motor vehicle fuel for the payments therein provided for, the said G. D. Frown has rendered services which have resulted in a finding by The Bureau of Inspection and Supervision of Public Offices, of the State of Ohio, against the City of Columbus and in favor of the City of Bexley in the sum of \$6,684.48 for fees and taxes due to the City of Bexley, but improperly paid to the City of Columbus, and

Whereas, the City of Columbus has passed an Ordinance No. 396-35, providing for the reimbursement to the City of Bexley for said overpayment to the City of Columbus for such motor vehicle license fees and gasoline taxes, the same being for the years 1930 and 1931, and

whereas, the said G. D. Brown has performed all services on his part to be performed in the recovery of said amount and under the terms of said ordinance is entitled to the sum of \$1336.90 for said services, and it is the desire of council that he shall be paid thereon at this time the sum of \$650.00, NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

G. D. Brown on account of said services, and the Auditor is authorized and directed to issue the necessary voucher therefor in said sum, the remainder of the amount so due to the said G. D. Brown to be paid upon the full payment by the City of Columbus of the amounts of said fees and taxes so found to be due.

Section 2. That for the purpose of making said payment hereinabove authorized there be and hereby is appropriated from the Yeneral Fund the sum of \$650.00.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
