

## ORDINANCE NO. 36-35.

To authorize the payment of the claim of B. A. Yenkin.

Whereas, on or about August 29th, 1935, at 8:00 o'clock P. M., the automobile owned and operated by B. A. Yenkin was damaged by reason of striking an open manhole in Lrexel Avenue near the intersection of Fair Avenue resulting in the bursting of a tire thereon, and

Whereas, the said B. A. Yenkin has suffered damages by reason of the aforesaid accident in the reasonable sum of \$9.02, NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the claim of B. A. Yenkin in the sum of \$9.02 for damages to the tire on his automobile sustained on or about August 29th, 1935, in the manner hereinabove set forth be and the same is hereby recognized as a moral obligation of the City of Bexley, and that the same be paid.

Section 2. That for the purpose of paying said claim there be and hereby is appropriated from the general fund the sum of \$9.02, and the auditor is hereby authorized and directed to draw proper voucher therefor upon receipt of release properly executed by the said B. A. Yenkin of all damages arising out of said accident.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law. Passed November 12, 1935,
