about August 29th, 1935, in the manner hereinabove set forth be and
the same is hereby recognized as a moral obligation of the City of
Bexley, and that the same be paid.

Section 2. That for the purpose of paying said claim there be and hereby is appropriated from the general fund the sum of \$\phi 9.02\$, and the auditor is hereby authorized and directed to draw proper voucher therefor upon receipt of release properly executed by the said B. A. Yenkin of all damages arising out of said accident.
