## ORDINANCE NO. 3-36.

Providing for modification of salaries for certain officials and appointees for the year 1936.

Whereas, in view of present economic conditions council deems it advisable temporarily to modify the salaries of certain officials and employees of the City as the same are fixed by Ordinance No. 93-31, passed December 22nd, 1931, NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That for the year 1936 the salaries of the following officials and appointees in lieu of the amounts fixed by Ordinance No. 93-31, passed December 22nd, 1931, shall be in the following amounts per annum payable monthly, to-wit:

(a) Superintendent of Streets

\$2,400.00

(h) Superintendent of Water

2,100.00
