

## ORDINANCE NO. 4-36.

Providing for modification of salary of Solicitor for the year 1936.

Whereas, in view of present economic conditions Council deems it advisable temporarily to modify the salary of the Solicitor as the same is fixed by Ordinance No. 89-31, passed December 22nd, 1931, during the year 1936, NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the salary of the Solicitor for the year 1936 shall be \$1,500.00 per annum, payable monthly, in lieu of the amount fixed by said Ordinance No. 89-31, passed December 22nd, 1931, for all services rendered as attorney and counsel for the City, and for all officers and departments thereof in matters relating to their official duties, provided, however, said Solicitor shall not be required to render service to said City or officials in any litigated matters for the salary and compensation aforesaid, but, in case his services should be required in any case or cases wherein said City or officials are involved, or about to be involved, in litigation, he shall receive for such services such sum or sums as may be agreed upon by such Solicitor and the Council. The Solicitor shall give bond in the sum of \$500.00.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law and shall be effective to and including the 31st day of December, 1936.
