

## ORDINANCE NO. 6-56.

To amend Section 5 of Ordinance No. 93-31, establishing administrative departments for the City of Bexley, passed December 22, 1931.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That Section 5 of Ordinance No. 93-31, establishing administrative departments for the City of Bexley, passed December 22, 1931, be amended as follows:

Section 5. The Mayor may appoint a secretary, who shall serve the Mayor, Auditor and the various administrative departments in the performance of their duties. Said appointment shall be at the pleasure of the Mayor, and said secretary shall receive a salary of \$120.00 per month. The Mayor may also appoint additional stenographers or clerks to serve the above mentioned officers and departments in cases of emergencies, special work requiring such help, or illness of incumbents; said employees shall be classified as classes a, b and c, and shall be compensated as follows, to-wit:

- Class (a) shall receive 40 cents per hour.
- Class (b) shall receive 45 cents per hour.
- Class (c) shall receive 50 cents per hour.

Section 2. That Ordinances Nos. 4-32, passed January 12, 1932, and 1-34, passed January 2, 1934, be and the same are hereby repealed.

Section 3. This ordinance is an emergency ordinance and necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety and the same shall go into immediate effect. Passed January 29, 1936.
