

ORDINANCE NO. 14-36.

By Mr. Harlor.

Authorizing the purchase of automobile truck for the Division of Parks and Public Grounds, and declaring an emergency.
BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and Auditor be and they are hereby authorized to enter into a contract for the purchase of one automobile truck chassis with closed cab and one-half ton truck pick-up body, front bumper, 4 ply tires, and with one extra tire, and not to exceed \$700.00 in price; and to exchange a Model T. Ford one-half ton truck with pickup body, Engine No. 12653549.

Section 2. That said contract shall be entered into with the lowest and best bidder after advertisement had according to law. The sum of \$700.00 is hereby appropriated from the general fund for the purpose aforesaid.

Section 3. This ordinance is an emergency ordinance and necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that said truck is necessary for the immediate operation of the Department of Parks and Public Grounds, and said ordinance shall go into force and effect upon the adoption thereof.
