

ORDINANCE NO. 16-36.

By Mr. Altmaier.

Authorizing the purchase of power lawn mower, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and Auditor be and they are hereby authorized to enter into a contract for the purchase of one power lawn mower for the use of the Division of Parks and Public Grounds, the same to cost not to exceed \$300.00, and to trade in thereon one gasoline motor mower, Detroit Model, 27 inch, No. D 106818, now belonging to the City.

Section 2. That the sum of \$300.00 is hereby appropriated from the general fund for the cost thereof.

Section 3. This ordinance is an emergency ordinance and necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and the same shall go into full force and effect upon the adoption thereof.
