

ORDINANCE NO. 18-36

By Mr. Altmaier.

Authorizing the installation of water connections on Powell Avenue street improvement, and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor be and he is hereby authorized to purchase the necessary materials, and through his Street Superintendent to install not to exceed twelve water connections in the improvement of Powell Avenue now under construction through the aid of the Works Progress Administration of the Federal Government.

Section 2. That the sum of \$400.00 is hereby appropriated from the Water Fund for the payment of the cost of said water connections.

Section 3. This ordinance is an emergency ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that the premises abutting upon Powell Avenue are without adequate supply of water for domestic use and fire protection, for which reason said ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect.
