

ORDINANCE NO. 24-36.

Providing for improvement of Sherwood Road from Remington Road to Gould Road, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That Council has determined and hereby does determine that it is necessary to improve Sherwood Road from Remington Road to Gould Road, by grading, draining, constructing concrete curbs and gutters, and paving the roadway thereof with macadam, and making necessary water connections, and that it hereby determines to proceed with said improvement, all in accordance with the plans, specifications, estimates and profiles prepared by the engineers and on file in the office of the Mayor, which are hereby approved.

Section 2. Whereas, the Works Progress Administration of the Public Works of the United States has proposed and agreed to furnish all labor in the making of said improvement, and a portion of the materials necessary therefor, and to make and perform said improvement on condition that the City of Bexley shall furnish the balance of said materials, and the necessary engineering services, said balance of materials and engineering services being in the estimated amount of \$5500.00, and whereas, The Standard Development Company, Inc., of 37 North Third Street, Columbus, Ohio, being the owner of certain premises located on Sherwood Road, has heretofore paid to The Jennings-Lawrence Company the sum of \$300.00 for the preparation of the necessary plans, specifications, estimates and profiles for said improvement, and has agreed to pay to and deposit with the Auditor of the City of Bexley the further sum of \$2,700.00 to be applied by the City of Bexley upon its portion of the cost of said improvement, to-wit: upon said sum of \$5,500.00, leaving a balance to be paid by the City of Bexley in the sum of \$2,500.00, the Council does ordain that said improvement shall be made in accordance with said proposal and agreement, and the Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into a contract for the purchase of said materials, according to the plans, specifications, estimates and profiles hereinabove referred to, after advertisement had according to law. The said Works Progress Administration is hereby authorized to enter upon said street and to cause said improvement to be made in

accordance with the foregoing provisions of this ordinance.

Section 3. That the sum of \$2,500.00, in addition to the deposit of said Standard Development Company, Inc., in said sum of \$2,700.00, is hereby appropriated from the Streets Maintenance and Repair Gasoline Tax Fund for the payment of the cost of said materials so to be furnished by the City.

Section 4. This ordinance is an emergency ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace and safety, said emergency being that said is becoming dangerous to traffic and is in need of immediate improvement, for which reason this ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect.
