

## ORDINANCE NO. 34-36.

Providing for payment of salary of Dorothy Christian, stenographer, for the month of September, 1936.

Whereas, Dorothy Christian has been temporarily ill during the month of September, 1936, and council being of the opinion that her salary should be paid during such temporary illness, NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Auditor be and he is hereby authorized and directed to pay the salary of Dorothy Christian, stenographer, during her temporary illness for the month of September, 1936 in the sum of \$120.00.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.


