By Mr. R. J. Wheaton.

Providing for the improvement and repair of Dale Avenue from Cassady Road to Cassingham Avenue, and Aster Avenue from College Avenue to Pleasant Ridge Avenue, by constructing concrete curbs and gutters on each side thereof, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF CHIO:

Section 1. That council has determined and hereby does determine that it is necessary to improve and repair Dale Avenue from Cassady Road to Cassingham Avenue, and Aster Avenue from College Avenue to Pleasant Ridge Avenue, by constructing concrete curbs and gutters on each side thereof, and that it hereby determines to proceed with said improvement, all in accordance with the plans, specifications, estimates and profiles prepared by the engineers and on file in the office of the Mayor, which are hereby approved.

Section 2. That whereas, the Works Progress Administration of the Public Works of the United States, has proposed and agreed to furnish all the labor in the making of said improvement, together with a portion of the materials necessary therefor, and to make and perform said improvement on condition that the City of Bexley shall furnish the balance of said mater ials and the inecessary engineering services, said balance of materials and engineering services being in the sum of \$2,000.00, said improvement shall be made in accordance with said proposal and agreement, and the mayor is hereby authorized to enter into a contract for the purchase of said materials according to law, and the engineers are instructed to furnish the necessary engineering services in preparation for and performance of such improvements.

Section 3. That the sum of \$2,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the Street Maintenance and Repair Gasoline Tax Fund for the payment of the cost of said materials and engineering services.

Section 4. This ordinance is an emergency ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that said streets are in immediate need of such improvement are repair and the winter season is rapidly approaching, for which reason said ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect.
