

## ORDINANCE NO. 41-36.

Authorizing the purchase of an automobile for the Police Department.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract for the purchase of one automobile for use of the Safety Department, said automobile to be a two door sedan with standard equipment, the cost thereof, over and above exchange of coach hereafter provided, not to exceed \$750.00, and to exchange thereon one 1933 Model, DeSoto Coach, Engine No. 23360, with all equipment excepting spotlight, radio, siren and fire extinguisher.

Section 2. That said contract shall be entered into with the lowest and best bidder after advertisement had according to law, said bid to contain the trade-in allowance for said DeSoto coach upon the purchase price so bid. The sum of \$750.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Fund for the purpose aforesaid.

Section 3. This ordinance is an emergency ordinance and necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and the same shall go into immediate force and effect.
