

ORDINANCE NO. 44-36.

Appropriating money for the cost of water connections in improvement of Sherwood Road from Remington Road to Gould Road.
BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That for the payment of the City's portion of the cost and expense of installing the necessary water connections under the improvement of Sherwood Road from Remington Road to Gould Road, which improvement is being made by the Works Progress Administration of the Public Works of the United States, there is hereby appropriated the additional sum of \$327.74 from the waterworks fund. Said waterworks fund shall be reimbursed for said costs by a payment of a service charge by the abutting owners at the time they shall respectively tap into said water lines, said payments to be at such rate per tap as will completely reimburse said fund, to be determined by the Superintendent of Water.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
