

ORDINANCE NO. 50-36.

Providing for bond for master plumbers licensed to perform work within the City of Bexley.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That any master plumber licensed to perform his trade within the City of Bexley, as provided in Ordinance No. 522, shall prior to the issuance of such license provide a bond to the approval of the Mayor in the penal sum of \$500.00, which bond shall be conditioned to reimburse the City of Bexley for all actual damages caused by any act or omission of said master plumber, to any property which the city may own, or for which it may be responsible, and to hold said City of Bexley free and harmless from all claims for damages on account of the negligence or misfeasance of said master plumber, and from all cost and expense growing out of the defense of such claims. Said bond shall be in force from the date of its acceptance and the issuance of such master plumbers license to the end of the year covered by said license and the same must be renewed annually on the re-issuance of such license.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
