Bexley City School District to grade Remington Road To Cassingham Road, and to connect their drainage system with the maniple approximately mid-way between Maryland Avenue and Ruhl Avenue on the west side of Cassingham Road, said manhole being in the 18 inch storm sewer in said Cassingham Road.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That permission is hereby granted to the Board of Education of the Bexley City School District to remove the dirt in Remington Road between Maryland Avenue and Ruhl Avenue, and in Ruhl Avenue between Remington Road and Cassingham Road down to the curb grade established by the city engineers and shown upon the plat of the proposed play-ground site of the Bexley, Ohio City School property, now on file in the office of the Mayor. The dirt so removed to be used on the said proposed play-ground site belonging to the said Board of Education.

Section 2. That permission be and the same is also granted to said Board of Education to make sewer connection for the drainage of the proposed Bexley school play-ground site by running a sewer connection across Cassingham Road to the manhole on the west side of Cassingham Road about midway between Maryland Avenue and Ruhl avenue, said manhole being in the 18 inch storm sewer running along the west side of Cassingham Road. This work to be done under the supervision of the City Engineers.

Section 3. This resolution is an emergency resolution, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and the same shall go into immediate force and effect.
