

## ORDINANCE NO. 15-37

By Mr. Altmaier.

Providing for repair of street signs.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor be authorized to purchase the necessary materials and to make repair of damaged and broken street signs throughout the City of Bexley.

Section 2. That the sum of \$400.00 is hereby appropriated from St. Maint. & Repair (Gas) Fund for the cost of making such repairs.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
