## ORDINANCE no. 17-37

By Mr. O. F. Rehn.

Establishing a City Planning Commission for the City of Bexley.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That there be and hereby is established a City Planning Commission to consist of the Mayor, the City Engineer, and three citizens of the City who shall serve without compensation, and who, with the concurrence of council, shall be appointed by the Mayor for terms of six years each, except that the terms of two of the citizens so appointed members of the first commission shall be for three years.

Section 2. The duties, powers and limitations of the Planning Commission may be prescribed by ordinance of council, and in the absence of such ordinance said Commission shall perform the duties and exercise the powers conferred upon City Planning Commissions by the Charter of the City, and by general laws of the state not inconflict with the Charter.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
