

ORDINANCE NO. 18-37.

By Mr. Harlor.

To make appropriation for the payment of the cost of grading and preliminary engineering services in the proposed improvement of Francis Avenue from Mound Street to Livingston Avenue.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That to provide a fund with which to pay that part of the cost of the grading, necessary materials for the installation of the sanitary sewers, drains and water lines, and preliminary engineering costs in the proposed improvement of Francis Avenue from Mound Street to Livingston Avenue, which are payable by the municipality under agreement entered into or to be entered into with the Works Progress Administration of the Federal Government for the doing of said work, there be and is hereby appropriated from the general fund the sum of \$3,000.00. Said general fund shall be reimbursed in the amount of said appropriation from the proceeds of bonds to be issued for said improvement.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
