

ORDINANCE NO. 19-37

By Mr. Harlor.

Providing for the repair and maintenance of certain streets in the City of Bexley by the application of oil to the surfaces thereof.

Whereas, certain streets in the City of Bexley are bearing a heavy burden of traffic, and the proper care and maintenance thereof require that the surface of such streets be treated with oil so as to prevent the annoyance of dust in the vicinity thereof, and to preserve the surface thereof, NOW, THEREFORE:


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and Auditor be, and they are hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract for the purchase, or for the purchase and application of the necessary oil for the treatment of such streets within the City, as in the opinion of the Mayor shall require such treatment, within the limits of the appropriation hereinafter provided.

Section 2. That the Sum of \$450.00 is hereby appropriated from the Maintenance and Repair of Streets Gasoline Tax Fund for the cost thereof.


Section 3. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency ordinance, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that said streets are in the need of immediate repair, and said ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect.
