ORDINANCE NO. 20-37

Providing for the maintenance and repair of certain streets, roads and avenues in the City of Bexley, Ohio BE IT ORDAINEDBY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That, whereas, Ardmore Road from Fair Avenue to Ruhl Avenue, Cassady Road from Brentwood Road to Broad Street; Cassingham Road from Elm Avenue to Ruhl Avenue, are in need of repairs so that the same may be maintained as proper highways; said streets, roads and avenues between said points shall be repaired by patching, sealing the cracks, and/or giving the same a surface treatment, in accordance with the specifications and estimates therefor prepared by the engineers and on file in the office of the Mayor, which specifications and estimates are hereby approved.

Section 2. That the sum of \$4,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the Maintenance and Repair of Streets Gasoline Tax Fund, and the sum of \$9,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the Maintenance and Repair of Streets, Motor Vehicle License Fund for the purpose of paying the cost thereof.

Section 3. That the Mayor and Auditor be and they are hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract for said repairs after advertisement had according to law.

Section 4. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency ordinance, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, by reason of the fact that said streets are fast deteriorating and at places are becoming unsafe for traffic, wherefore said ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect.
